NS Forestry Dept building fish conservation centre

SEREMBAN: The state Forestry Department hopes to complete a fish conservation centre and hatchery in Sungai Kenaboi, Jelebu, by early next year. Its director, Saleh Awaludin, said the RM120,000 project aimed to conserve fish diversity and protect rare species, like *kelah*. He said discussions with various parties such as the state Fisheries Department were in progress. "The objective is to enrich our rivers with local fish species and we are selecting Sungai Kenaboi as its water is clean and unpolluted. The location is also rich in biodiversity and there used lots of *kelah* in Sungai Kenaboi but now they are now difficult to find due human activities, such as illegal fishing." He said the sanctuary was modelled on the Sungai Chiling Fish Sanctuary in Kuala Kubu Baru, Selangor and the Royal Belum Park in Perak. **Bername**
